

# PERMITS for NON-PARKS uses of Parks Property



## Proposed Changes for 2017-2018 Fees and Charges

Seattle Parks and Recreation proposed fee changes for permits for non-parks uses of parks property provide clarity for current 2017-2018 proposed fees (for participants or fee collection systems) and formalize fees for special use.
