Around the World Watercolor

Bring any story to life through pen and paper! Students will learn to write for their desired genre, using concepts and prompts to bring characters to life like spies, aliens, wizards, dragons, or even everyday humans. Young authors will make their own books by the end of camp.

Art Camp

All levels of experience are invited to exercise their creativity, and explore a variety of artistic mediums which include drawing, painting, and sculpture.

Dance Jams & Hip Hop History

If your child is energetic and passionate about dance, they will enjoy learning the expressive world of Hip Hop dance! Kids will be introduced to multiple styles of Hip Hop, learning the foundational movements of bboying/bgirling including toprock, footwork, freezes, and power moves.

Silly Moves with Moving Minds

Little ones will be thrilled with a chance to let their silly selves shine, taking on different characters every day. Camp will begin each day with a story that will set the theme for our dance class & crafts. As princesses, superheroes, wild things, and more, dancers will exercise their imaginations. We will read different books each week of camp.

Worlds of Chess

Students will outsmart their opponents and become a chess master! Your child will learn a variety of game strategies, from basic moves to advanced maneuvers. Develop your child's individual growth, good sportsmanship, and critical thinking skills. Must have basic knowledge of chess, we will be using 3rd party platforms shared in camp.

Hockey

Tweens Dungeons & Dragons

Campers will move through a virtual playground while collaborating and producing multi-media presentations. Each day we will learn about a new topic of D&D including: building resilience, supporting public health, advocating for justice, decolonization, and understanding digital responsibility. 3rd party platforms may be used and share to campers during camp.
