Preschool summer day camps meet the developmental needs of young children. focusing on emotional, social, physical, and cognitive skills to prepare children for success in school and in life.

- Children need to be fully potty-trained (no diapers or pull-ups permitted)

- One-time \$50 registration fee for Preschool Summer **Day Camps.**
- \$25 non-refundable/non-transferable deposit for each week included in price

- Participation requires submittal of the appropriate registration forms PRIOR to the start of program. including the Participant Information and Authorization Form (E-13) or ePact. Parents must complete and submit all required registration forms including the Participant Information and Medical History before registration is complete. If your child takes medication, a doctor's signature is required. Scholarship applications are available and DSHS Developmental Disabilities Administration Respite Care subsidies are also accepted.

FEES AND CHARGES
